I. Background

1. Historical background and causes of the problem.
2. What people, groups, and/or countries are directly involved with or affected by the issue?
3. What effect does this problem have on the local, national, and international community?

II. Character Biography

1. Your character's history.
2. Your character's involvement (if any) with the topic.
3. Your character's position and policy on the topic, and affiliation with other characters or groups.
4. Your character's past actions regarding the topic.
5. Your character's potential powers.

III. Proposed Plans and Solutions

1. Your character's proposed plans and solutions in dealing with the issue.
 2. Your character's potential personal arc and ideas of what you hope to accomplish in committee.
 3. Who do you plan to work with in committee? Who are your potential allies? Who are your potential enemies?
- This should be the longest section.

Logistics:

- 5 pages maximum (Works Cited does not count towards the 5 pages).
- 12 point font, Times New Roman, double-spaced, 1-inch margins.
- Works Cited should be endnotes with links.
